English

In our English lessons we will be focusing on the book, Greta and the Giants. This is linked to the climate and how we can look after the world. We will be looking at explanation texts, debates and persuasive letters all based around the climate and how we need to look after the world we live in.

PE

This half term, we will focus on invasion games. We will begin by working with Leicester Tigers to improve our tag rugby skills and then move on to other invasion games, where we will look to try and move to create space, work together as a team and invade an opponent's area to score a goal!

Science

After finishing our unit on States of Matter, we will move on this term to study 'Sound'. We will look at the structure of the ear and how sound waves work. We will also look at pitch and volume and conduct our volume experiment.

Music

In music, we will be learning about pitch which will link with our science lessons. We will investigate the range of sounds that different instruments make, finally leading to creating our compositions for a Tom and Jerry clip!

In our PSHE lessons, we will be looking at how healthy eating, physical activity, sleep and the use of free time make up a healthy lifestyle. We will look at how the decision we take to keep ourselves healthy can affect us both physically and mentally.
