Learning Together to Enjoy and Achieve

English: We will continue to find answers to our question: 'How are families affected by War?' through reading picture books relating to World War II and writing newspaper reports, letters and poems. We will celebrate our learning through creating an anthology of poems. We will continue to read Friend or Foe by Michael Morpurgo.

Maths: In Maths, we will begin by learning about ratio - how to use the associated language and the symbol. We will then introduce simple algebraic equations. After this we will extend our knowledge of decimal numbers, linking this to our fractions learning and preparing for percentages.

Science: This term we will be studying Light. We will look at how light appears to travel, how we see things and testing materials for reflectiveness.

Music:

This term we will be analysing and performing a collection of songs and music from World War Two and begin to learn some basic keyboard skills.

PSHE:

Our PSHE focus this term is 'Dreams and Goals'. We will initially look at personal goals before looking more at collaborative goals.

Art & DT:

In DT, the children will have the opportunity to design and then make their own evacuee's teddy bear.

P.E. and Games:

PE will be on Monday and Thursday this term. We will learn basic volleyball skills in our indoor sessions and develop our lacrosse skills in our outdoor lessons. Please ensure that your child has appropriate indoor and outdoor PE kit in school at all times.

RE:

We will be looking at a variety of beliefs about what happens after someone dies. We encourage you to discuss this topic at home as well.

Computing:

The children will explore variables in programming through games such as Scratch.

Spanish:

The children will learn the nouns for sports, be able to give their opinion on sports they like and dislike, as well as using the verb 'jugar' (to play) in different forms.
