## English

In English, we will begin the term by learning about spring and exploring the different life cycles of animals during this season. We will then move on to the story 'We're Going on a Treasure Hunt', comparing it with similar texts. Throughout the term, we will be developing our writing skills by extending our sentences and using a wider range of vocabulary. We will also continue our under-the-sea theme by reading a range of linked stories. In Summer 2, we will study 'This is the Bear' and create our own versions of the story. We will also explore non-fiction texts related to toys. We will finish the term by focusing on summer poetry, working hard to perform poems and compose our own.

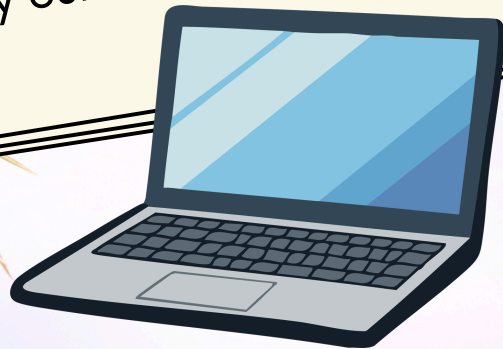
## Science

In Science, we will continue exploring different microhabitats and the animals that live within them. We will investigate our school grounds to discover what we can find! We will also spend time learning about plants, including how they grow and what they need to survive. In addition, we will continue observing seasonal changes throughout the year, focusing on spring and summer, and comparing them to autumn and winter.



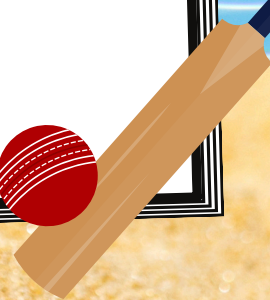
## Computing

In Computing, we will be using technology to support our art unit. We will learn how to create digital content inspired by our under-the-sea theme.



## PE

This term, the children will be developing their skills in striking and fielding games. We will also be preparing for Sports Day by taking part in a range of athletics activities!



## Art

In Art, we will spend time exploring watercolours. We will link this to our 'Under the Sea' theme, thinking about different techniques and skills we can use when painting. We will also explore a range of shades and tones within colours.



## Maths

In Maths, we will continue our unit on multiplication and division, ensuring we are confident when counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. We will then move on to fractions, where we will learn how to find a half and a quarter. After this, we will explore place value to 100. In Summer 2, we will focus on position and direction, learning to use left and right accurately. We will finish the term with a unit on money, where we will learn the value of different coins and notes, before moving on to telling the time.

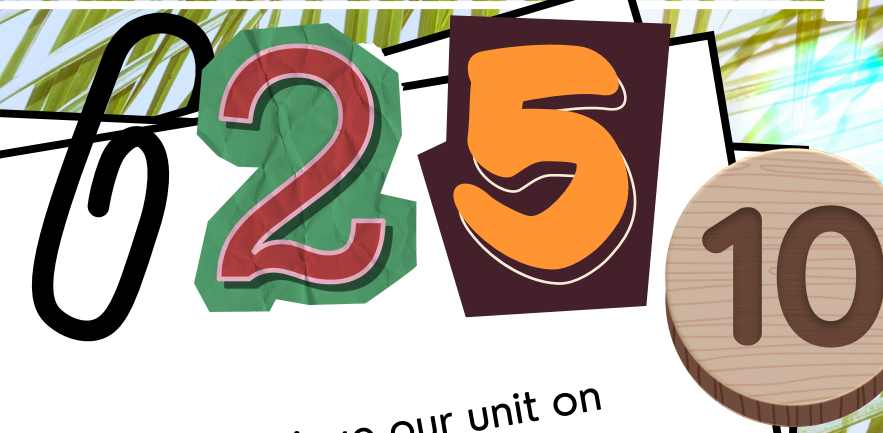
## History

In History, we will explore the history of toys. We will observe how toys have changed over time, in terms of the types of toys available, as well as how the toys are made. We will spend time learning about Hornby Trains and how they have been influential to society.



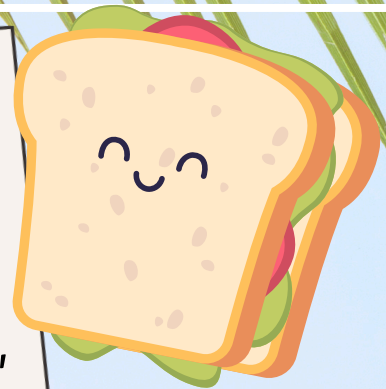
## RE

This term, we will be taking part in some new RE learning. We will be learning about the religion of Islam, finding out how Muslim people live and how they celebrate their faith. We will also explore what makes places sacred and discuss what it means for something to be special or sacred to us.



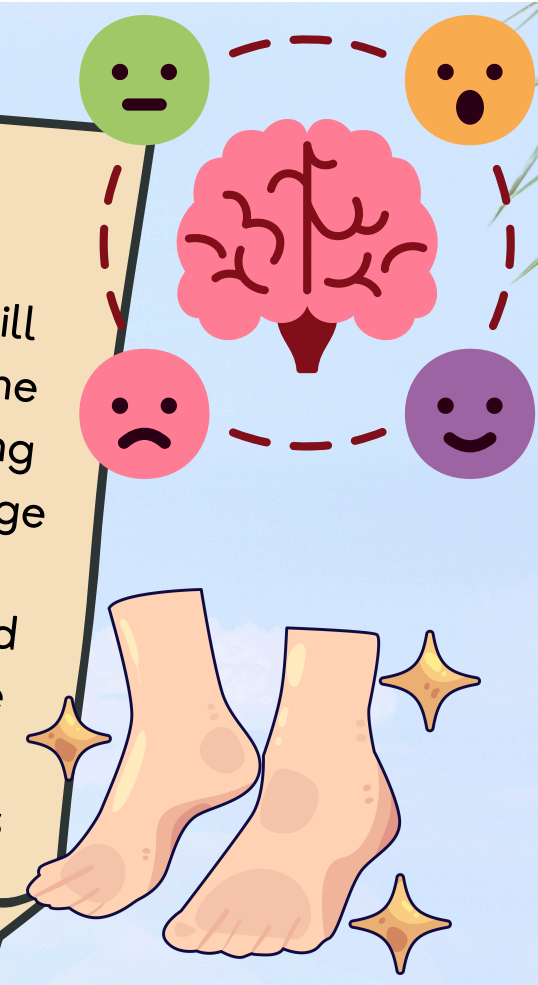
## DT

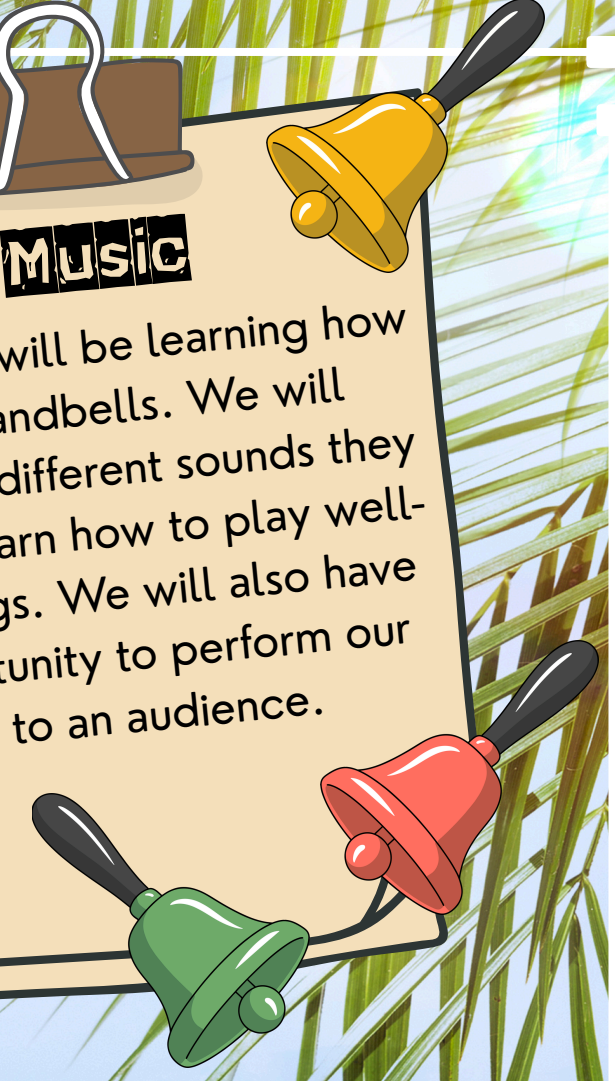
## PSHE

Our PSHE sessions this term will focus on two different units. One unit will be focused on managing change and managing how change makes us feel. We will be identifying different emotions and why we feel these emotions. We will also end the term with a unit on RSE. Thinking about our bodies and how we can keep ourselves clean and healthy.

In Music, we will be learning how to play handbells. We will explore the different sounds they make and learn how to play well-known songs. We will also have the opportunity to perform our music to an audience.



## Geography

In Geography, we will be continuing our unit about the United Kingdom. We will continue to think about the four countries that make up the UK. We will be understanding different human and physical features. As well as identifying key landmarks in the UK. We will be understanding how the countries in the UK are similar and different to each other.
