Our Sports Day this year is next **Wednesday**, **25**th **June**. The plan for the day is as follows:

On the day children should come to school in their P.E kit with a House-coloured T-shirt, no vest tops please. (Chestnut – blue; Maple – red; Rowan – yellow (PE t-shirt is fine) or white; Beech-green) Every child will need to have a named water bottle, named sun hat and have had sun cream applied before they come to school.

You're very welcome to bring a picnic to enjoy with your child on the day. Parents of children in EYFS and KS1 are invited to return at 12:00pm to join the picnic too. Please remember that we are a nut-free school, so all food must be free from nuts. Attendance at the picnic is optional. If you're unable to attend, please be assured that your child will be supervised by staff. If you are returning for the picnic, please enter via the school office from 12:00pm. Children will be seated in a designated area.

After 40 minutes, there will be a tannoy announcement. At this point, parents with children in EYFS and KS1 will be asked to leave promptly so we can prepare for the KS2 afternoon session. For children having a school dinner, the school dinner on Wednesday 25th June will be either a beef or vegetarian burger with a whole piece of fruit, vegetable sticks and a biscuit.

This means that all children will have a picnic outside, with or without their parents.

Advance Notice: Oaks Nursery Car Park Closure

We want to give families advance notice that from **7th July - 4th August**, resurfacing work will begin on Parkwood Road, which will **close access to the Oaks Nursery car park**. This will cause significant disruption and delays for those travelling to and from school. There will be a signed diversion route that will be in place through the Kent University housing complex. Along this route, there are a three small car parks that may offer limited parking. We're grateful to Kent University, who have kindly continued to allow our parents and carers to park considerately in these areas during drop-off and pick-up times. If you plan to use the diversion route, please allow extra time, drive carefully, and be mindful of residents. Where possible, we encourage families to walk, cycle or scoot to school to help ease congestion. We're sharing this early so you can plan ahead. Thank you for your understanding and support.
