Reading Year 6 – End of Key Stage 2 – 2023, 2024 and 2025

In 2025, 81.8% of our Kingsclere CE Primary School Year 6 children achieved the expected standard (EXS) in Reading which is above National and Hampshire averages.

Reading - achieved standard



In 2025, 45.5% of our Year 6 children achieved Greater Depth Standard (GDS) in Reading. This GDS attainment places us above National and Hampshire averages.

Our Reading scaled scores, in 2025, are also above National and Hampshire averages.

Writing – Year 6 – End of Key Stage 2 – 2023, 2024 and 2025

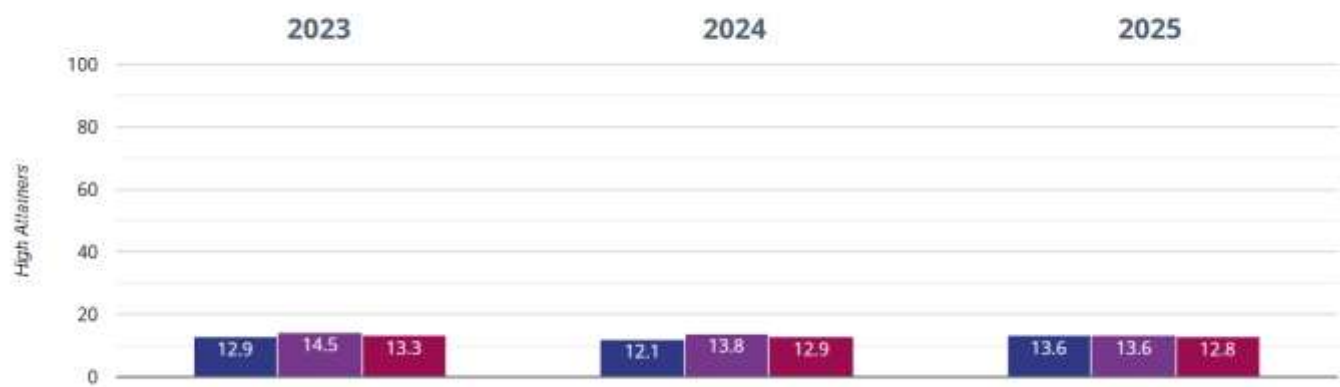
In 2025, 81.8% of our Year 6 pupils achieved the expected standard in Writing. This outcome is above both the National and Hampshire averages. Furthermore, our school underwent external moderation this year, which confirmed the accuracy and robustness of our teacher assessment judgements in Writing.

13.6% of our Year 6 children achieved Greater Depth Standards (GDS) in writing in 2025 which is in line with Hampshire averages and slightly above National.

Maths – Year 6 – End of Key Stage 2 – 2023, 2024 and 2025

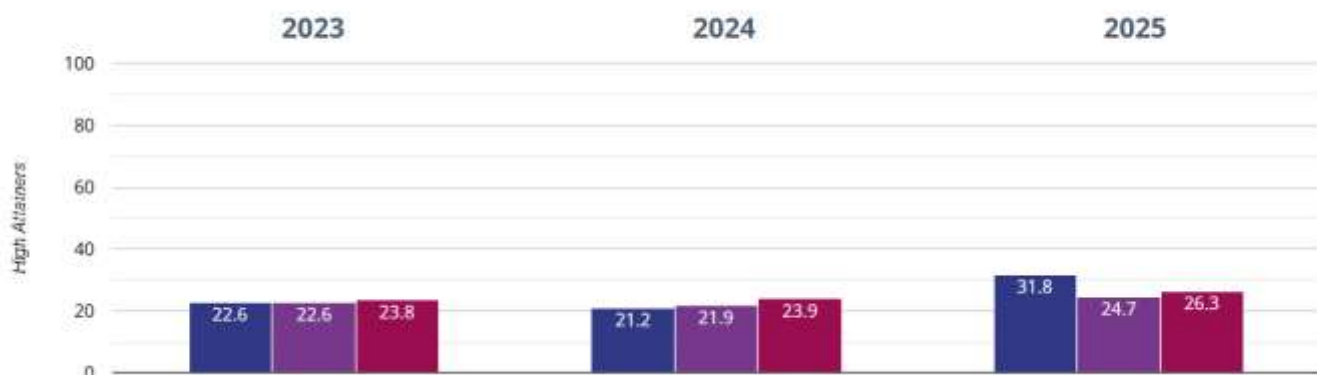
In 2025, 68.2% of our Year 6 children achieved the expected standard in Maths.

Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling – Year 6 – End of Key Stage 2 – 2023, 2024 and 2025

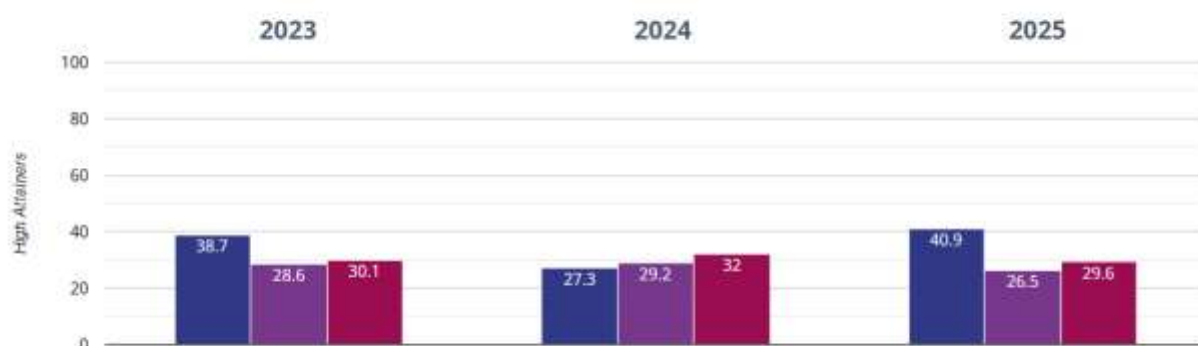
81.8% of children achieved the expected standards in Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling in 2025 which is above National and Hampshire standards.

The average scaled score for children in Year 6 in 2025 in Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling is above National and Hampshire averages.

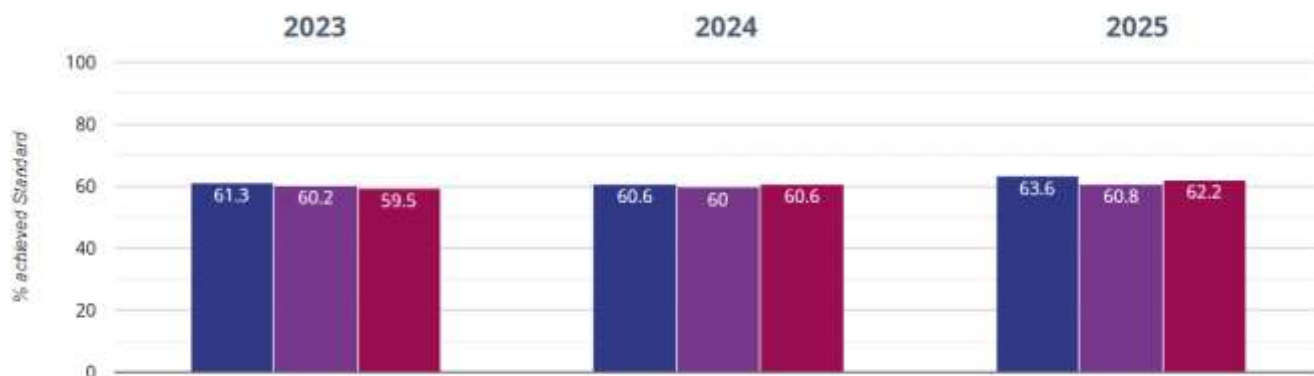

Combined results (Reading, Writing and Maths) in Year 6 – 2023, 2024 and 2025

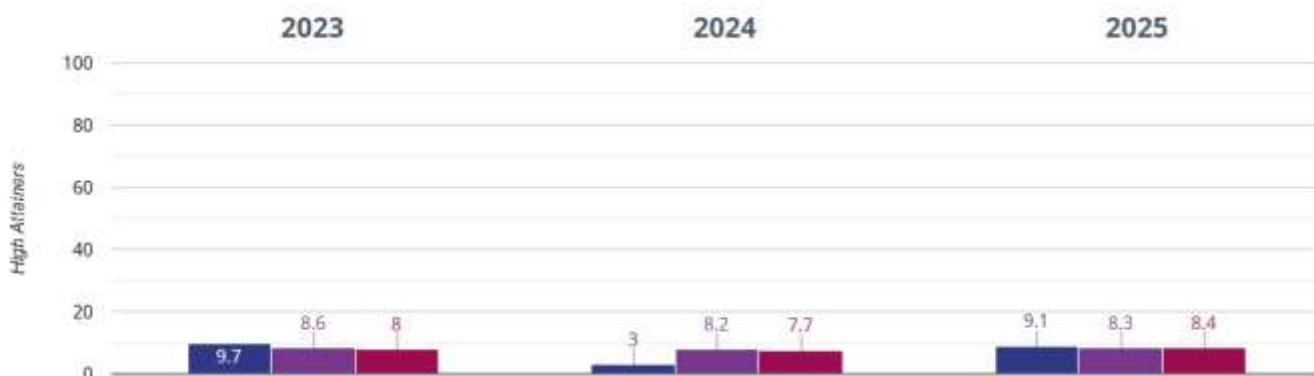
