Reading Ages


We will test your reading age and place you in groups according to your reading ability

- Green readers = 12 months below, on or above your chronological age
- Amber readers = 13 months 35 months below your chronological age
- **Red readers** = 36 months or more below your chronological age



How will the reading sessions work?

- You sit up straight
- You have the book in front of you
- Your teacher reads to you
- You follow the text
- Red readers will be provided with targeted support during this time.


