- Provide a safe and happy environment where all Pupils are valued, respected and listened to.
- Achieve high standards of behaviour by providing opportunities for Pupils to develop positive relationships, self-esteem and a sense of responsibility.
- Teach your child about our school values including the rights of the child
- Teach your child to develop a positive attitude to others, regardless of differences
- Promote high standards and high expectations of effort and progress to ensure our Pupils achieve their potential.
- Keep you informed about your child's progress and behaviour, as well as their termly curriculum experiences.
- Deal with parental concerns promptly and inform Parents/Carers of how they have been resolved.
- Provide regular opportunities to develop learning at home which are realistic, achievable and related to work in class
- Allow Pupils safe and secure use of the Internet through a combination of site filtering, supervision and by fostering a responsible attitude in all pupils, in partnership with parents.
- Promote good attendance and punctuality at all times
- Maintain good communication with parents, keeping you well informed about school life, via the school app

Our Pupils will...

- Be respectful, be responsible and ready to learn.
- Be responsible for their school and home learning, completing all tasks as well as they can, asking questions when they do not understand.
- Show that they are willing to work to the best of their ability.
- Accept responsibility for the things they do and reflect on their behaviour and learning and learn from all experiences.
- Come to school on time, prepared for the day and wearing the correct school uniform.
- Use the internet safely as taught in class.
- Talk to a grown-up if they have a problem.
- Demonstrate the school's values
- Take good care of the school building, equipment and resources.
- Follow class rules as set out in their class charter



Our Parents will...

- Support their child to be respectful, responsible and ready to Learn
- Having chosen our school for their child, accept the school's aims, policies and procedures, and positively support the school.
- Ensure their child wears the correct school uniform and follows the school dress code at all times (including for PE).
- Ensure that their child attends school punctually every day during term time, unless there is a good reason for absence (e.g. illness).
- Notify the school through the app or by telephone in the event of any absence.
- Support the school's policies and guidelines on dealing with behaviour, attendance and uniform.
- Support the school values including respect and responsibility.
- Support opportunities provided by the school to enhance their child's learning, including attending regular meetings to discuss their child's progress.
- Support their child with any home learning that is set, including reading regularly.
- Keep the school informed of any changes in contact information or family circumstances (i.e. address, phone number, emergency contacts etc.)
- Promptly inform the school of any concerns or problems that may affect their child's learning, behaviour or happiness at school
- Support the school in the teaching of safe and secure internet use at home.
- Respect all members of the school community, abiding by the policy of zero tolerance towards rude and aggressive behaviour, including inappropriate use of social media.
