
BLEAN PRIMARY SCHOOL – KEY STAGE 2 RESULTS 2018



The DfE introduced a new primary accountability system in 2014 which was implemented in 2016 through reformed primary assessment. This includes a new 'expected standard' (a higher standard than in previous years), along with new national curriculum tests in English Reading and Mathematics, with outcomes reported as scaled scores ranging from 80 to 120, rather than levels. A scaled score of 100 is the expected standard. Writing is via teacher assessment and those pupils who achieved a higher standard in Writing are also described as 'working at greater depth'.
