Key facts we are learning this term:

Vikings originate from Norway, Denmark and Sweden, a group of countries which are known as Scandinavia.#

The word 'Viking' means pirate or raider.

The Viking era existed between 700 AD and 1100 AD.

The first major Viking raid happened in 793 AD at a monastery in Lindesfarne, North East England.

Danegeld was a tax paid to Viking raiders to stop them attacking.

The rule of law was known as Danelaw. Vikings most famous mode of transport are the long ships.

Most Vikings came to England to settle, however some attacked and some fled their homelands.
