English:

The texts we are reading and discussing this term are:

The Iron Man Book by Ted Hughes

We will be looking at writing in a variety of different forms including narrative and non-fiction.

Science:

Our science focus for this half term will be on digestion. We will be building on previous knowledge of animal diets and looking at how teeth have adapted. Additionally, we will learn about organs and the process of digesting food.

French:

We will be learning the vocabulary for items school stationery and putting this into sentences.

Art

Our Art focus is sculpture.
